# **OPEN SESSION**

The meeting was called to order at 8:03 a.m.

Mr. Reeser made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda items. Mr. Padgett seconded; motion carried.

Anthem Claims Summary (2020/2021) – Ms. Halford reported Plan medical claim payouts have decreased 10.2% when compared to 2020 through the second month of the 2021 calendar year.

## MoDOT/MSHP Prescription Drug Paid Claims Monthly Comparison (2020/2021) -

Ms. Halford reported Plan prescription claims costs have increased 4.3% when compared to 2020 through the second month of the 2021 calendar year.

<u>Anthem</u> - Ms. Halford welcomed Anthem staff to the meeting. Ms. Vojicic gave an Anthem update and new additions to the staff.

Beacon Behavioral Health- Anthem aquired Beacon Behavioral Health in 2020 giving Anthem the ability to combine behavioral health with the large network of providers within Anthem. Ms. Dalen and Ms. Ford presented to the Board how Beacon Behavioral Health and Anthem will integrate to improve the care for the members.

4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Update- Ms. Milus presented the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter report to the Board. She reported a total of \$93.3 million in medical claims through 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2020. This is a 5.72% increase from the prior reporting period in 2020. 95.1% of those claims were paid in network with a total of 55.4% of network discounts.

<u>PillarRx Quarterly Update-</u> Ms. Halford welcomed PillarRx staff to the meeting.

<u>4th Quarter Update-</u> Ms. Keeven and Ms. Weiss presented the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2020

update to the Board. Ms. Keeven reported the Copay Assistance program has saved the Plan over \$2.4 million through 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2020. The Plan currently has 248 members utilizing drugs on Co-pay assistance with a total drug count of 72.

<u>Other Business-</u> Ms. Halford gave a monthly COVID-19 update along with the impacts on the Plan. Total COVID-19 medical spend since the beginning of the pandemic has been just over \$3.8 million.

Ms. Halford also gave an update on employee COVID-19 vaccination clinics.

Mr. Reeser made a motion to adjourn at 10:25 a.m. Mr. Coffey seconded; motion carried.
